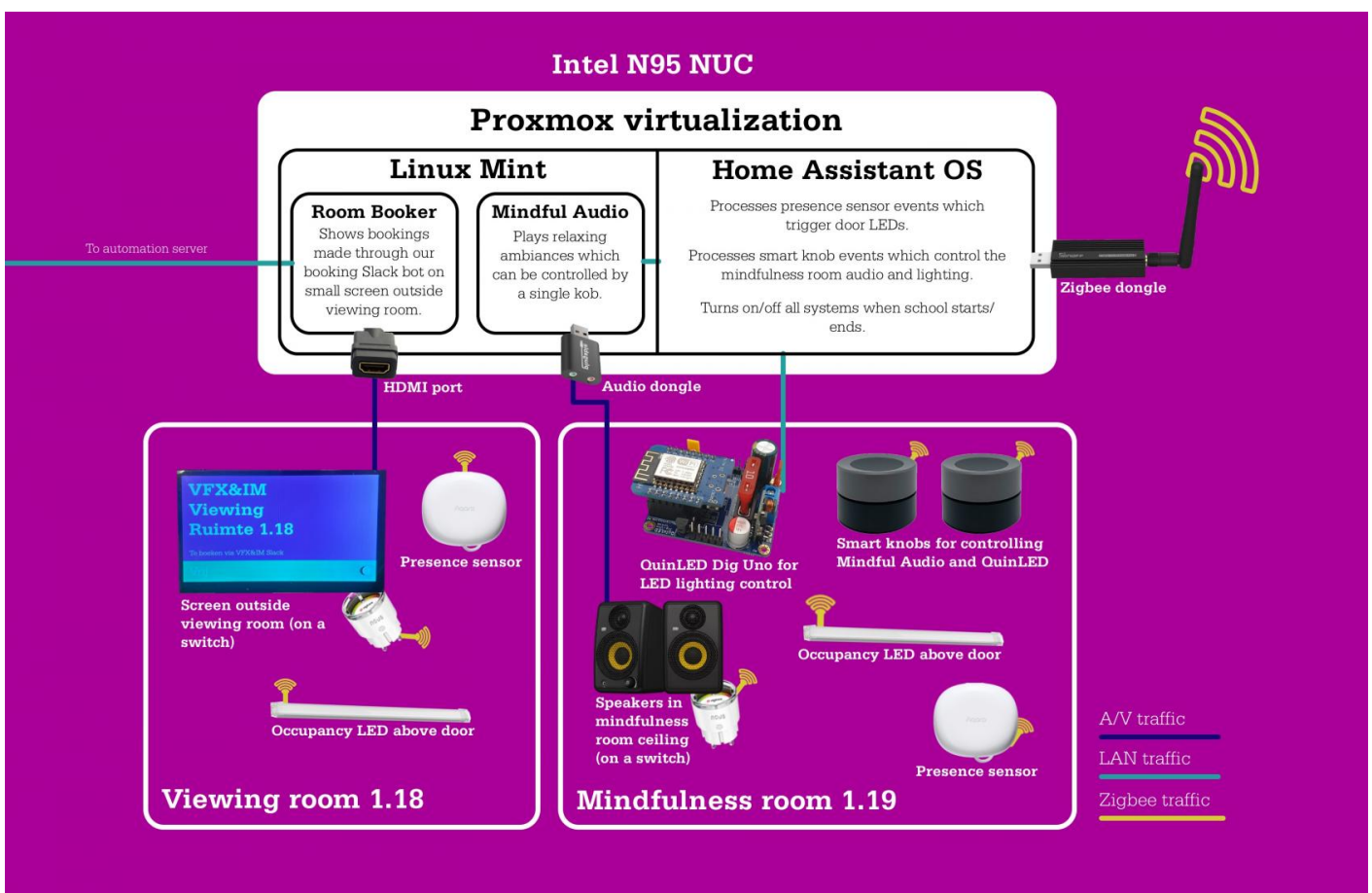


Pipeline - Explanations - Mindfulness room audiovisual installation

Here's an infographic:



The proxmox instance can be accessed on: <https://145.90.27.92:8006> (username is root, the password used is the old super *user* password that was used in the Deadline monitor some time ago). You can SSH into it using the same credentials.

The Home Assistance instance on: <http://145.90.27.99:8123> (username is vfxim, the password used is the old super *user* password that was used in the Deadline monitor some time ago)

And you can log into the Mint machine with: `ssh vfxim@145.90.27.152` (the password used is the old super *user* password that was used in the Deadline monitor some time ago)

Hardcoded IPs

There are three points in the system that use hardcoded IP addresses. Seeing as the proxmox, home assistant and mint instances don't have static IP addresses this might cause some problems at some point. Here's what you should do when this happens.

Home Assistant IP Changed

SSH into the Proxmox server and change the IP in the script that you can open with `nano /usr/local/bin/restart_vm_and_display.sh`. (The display has to be on when the VM auto reboots as it won't have a GUI otherwise, so that's why the Home Assistant IP is needed)

Browse to the Docker backend, find the Farm Facts container and change the IP address used in the `.env` file.

Linux Mint IP Changed

Browse to the Home Assistant instance, go to the Visual Studio Code server and change the `send_to_sound_system` IP string that you can find in `configuration.yaml`
